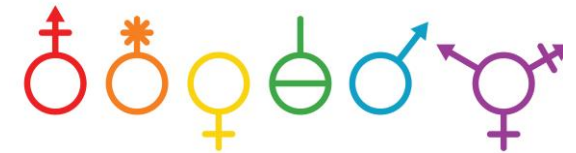
Amanda is a passionate fighter for putting queer lives at the centre of knowledge-making for more than 20 years.
